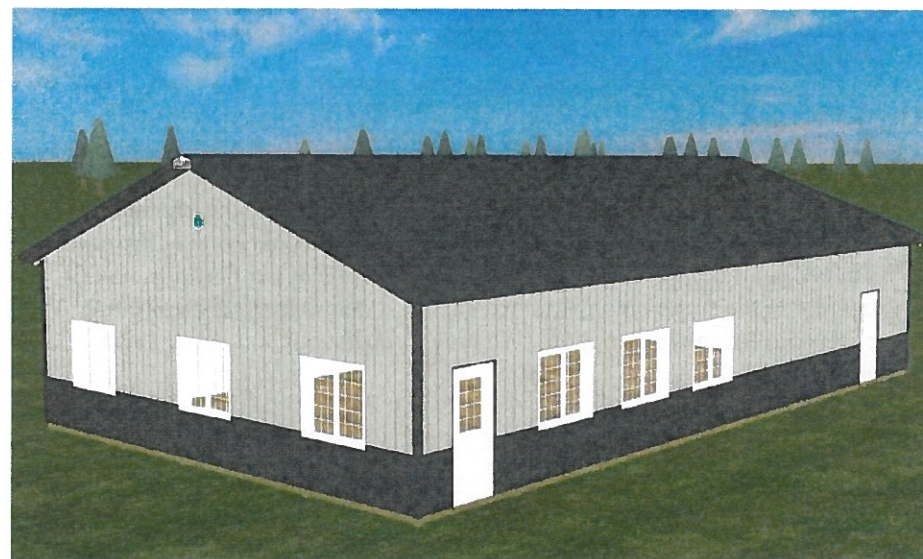

Luke 6: 47-49

P: The Holy Gospel according to the 6th Chapter of St. Luke.

⁴⁷I will show you what someone is like who comes to me, hears my words, and acts on them. ⁴⁸That one is like a man building a house, who dug deeply and laid the foundation on rock; when a flood arose, the river burst against that house but could not shake it, because it had been well built. ⁴⁹But the one who hears and does not act is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. When the river burst against it, immediately it fell, and great was the ruin of that house."

Order for Groundbreaking

P: Brothers and sisters in Christ: We have come together to seek God's blessing as we set apart this ground for the expansion and renovation of our facilities.

A: A reading from the book of Exodus: Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian; he led his flock beyond the wilderness, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire

out of a bush; he looked, and the bush was blazing, yet it was not consumed. Then Moses said, "I must turn aside and look at this great sight, and see why the bush is not burned up." When the Lord saw that he had turned aside to see, God called to him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" And he said, "Here I am." Then he said, "Come no closer! Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." Ex.3:1-7

The Blessing of Ground and Congregation

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

C: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

P: We give you thanks, O God, creator of the universe, for you laid the foundation of the earth, you determined its measurements, and you stretched the line upon it, when the morning stars sang together and the heavenly beings shouted for joy.

You fill the whole world with your presence; all the earth is holy ground.

We bless you for the good things of your creation that will be shaped into a place of worship and witness, and especially today for this space, which we set apart for the expansion of this church building.

You spin the stars around the heavens, you are the dwelling place of light: make this to be a place where your glory dwells in the light of your word and sacraments.

You give birth to the rain, your waters break forth in the desert: may your gracious blessing descend like dew from heaven upon all whom you will gather here to worship and send from here to serve.

We praise you for the joy of beginning a work in your name and for all whose gifts and labor have prepared for this day.

May we soon gather here to hear your Word and celebrate your Sacraments of the New Covenant, learning to serve our neighbor and, in the time to come, praise you forever in our eternal home; through Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

Breaking of the Ground

A: Praise the Lord, all you nations!

C: Extol him, all you peoples!

A: For great is his steadfast love toward us,

C: And the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever.

The Pastor turns three spadeful of earth, saying:

P: With faith in Jesus Christ, this work is begun and this ground is broken in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.
